Liz:

Matt is in a good place right now – very happy – exhibiting a very even temperament.

Iohn:

This is the longest period he's seen him really be himself and amenable

Colin:

Finances

John:

Were doing better financially than we thought we'd be doing. We have a grant from New Trier Township, checks and support from the Kuffners, Molinaros and Eichars. Flip is increasing his support from \$60 to \$100 on a monthly Jewel gift card.

Action Plan

Yikes

Liz:

Natayia has been in contact with Liz recently. Liz talked to her about Yikes and the work it entails. Natayia is interested and willing to take on Liz's bookkeeping & some management responsibilities for YIKES! (paid salary)

John:

- Natayia's interest in working with Matt is a game -changer. She knows Matt, the system and how things should work out with Matt.
- Liz has begun to train her as a backup for Yikes.
- Weekly YIKES! work to run \$100 per week.
- We need to raise \$5,000 a year for Nataiya to help with Yikes. John offered to pay for the training costs. Lee offered to pay for half the cost. Flip offered to pay for the other half.

Long Term Planning

John:

John asked to meet online with Lee, Shea, Allister and Courtney in August to go over his bookkeeping duties.

Liz:

We're looking at pursuing three possible future options:

- Matt staying in Chicago
- Christian Science residential group homes in the Bay Area (Twelveacre)
- Options in the San Diego area: Courtney and Liz met with providers in San Diego and were impressed with one of them. Courtney reported on the option in the San Diego area. Liz gave more details and answered questions about all three options.
